## CHESS Board

01

- Provides the strategic vision
- Provides approval for any policy required
- Takes recommendations and makes the final decisions on vision and policy
- Takes responsibility for the CHESS budget
- Oversees all funding decisions
- Drives all legislative efforts

## CHESS Executive Committee

02

- Controls operations
- Leads Project Management and Change Management (including Communications/Training)
- Executes the Board's vision
- Decides on contracts
- Manages CHESS-level staffing
- Engages and acts as liaison with contractors

## Steering Committee

03

- Reviews issue escalations
- Oversees how the Colleges work together (working agreements)
- Uses project reports to make decisions and/or recommendations
- Recommends policy
- Oversees schedule, scope and budget
- Creates sub-committees and/or working groups as needed
