# Role of the Governance Body by Group

## CHES Board

- Provide the strategic vision
- Provide approval for any policy required
- Take recommendations and make final decisions on vision and policy
- Take responsibility for the CHES budget
- Oversee all funding decisions
- Drive all legislative efforts

## CHES Executive Committee

- Control Operations
- Lead Project Management and Change Management
- Execute the Board's Vision
- Decide on contracts
- Manage CHES-level staff
- Engage and act as liaison with contractors

## Workday Executive Steering Committee

- Review issue escalations
- Oversee how the colleges work together
- Use project reports to make decisions and/or recommendations
- Recommend policy
- Oversee project schedule, scope, and budget
- Create sub-committees and/or working groups as needed

# Role of the Governance Body by Group

## Workday ERP Stakeholder Committee

- Support and lead the successful completion of the Workday ERP system implementations
- Make key strategic decisions and resolve any issues that impact the timeline, budget, or scope of the deployment projects, including decisions for production-level operations, active deployments, and planning of upcoming solution releases
- Determine reasonable outcomes on issues escalated up from the PMO, Data Reporting, and ERP workstream teams
- Advise lower committees and teams when called upon

## Workday SIS Stakeholder Committee

- Support and lead the successful completion of the Workday SIS system implementations
- Make key strategic decisions and resolve any issues that impact the timeline, budget, or scope of the deployment projects, including decisions for production-level operations, active deployments, and planning of upcoming solution releases
- Determine reasonable outcomes on issues escalated up from the PMO, Data Reporting, Academic Policy Committee, and SIS workstream teams
- Advise lower committees and teams when called upon

## Workday Academic Policy Committee

- Determine outcomes involving academic policy changes or impacts to ensure alignment and compliance with institutional accreditation requirements
- Evaluate impact decisions for specific institutions and across multiple institutions as well as on project scope, budget, and timeline
- Escalate issues to Change Board and SIS Stakeholder Committee for resolution as needed.
- Advise SIS Workstream teams and leadership committees to ensure that academic policies are aligned and in compliance with institutional requirements

## Workday Change Board

- Determine outcomes that align with the vision and goals of the CHES member institutions.
- Review, assess, evaluate, and recommend a course of action to the ERP / SIS Stakeholder committees.
- Work with the PMO to determine the best plan to implement and communicate approved change requests.
- Advise change requestors and leadership committees to assist with understanding the impacts of a change request and how to modify requests to align with business needs of the CHES institutions
